## Course content

Visual Arts is a combination of the creative aspects of both Art and Digital Media. From an Art perspective it involves developing different mark making skills such as drawing, painting, printing and photo manipulation. Within Digital Media it involves looking at the creative elements of it including animation, image manipulation/creation, video skills and website development.

Visual Arts will work on a ‘carousel’ structure and each week pupils will have a lesson with a different teacher to learn a new skill in that lesson. At the end of each carousel pupils will be given a choice of which aspect they would like to be assessed in.
