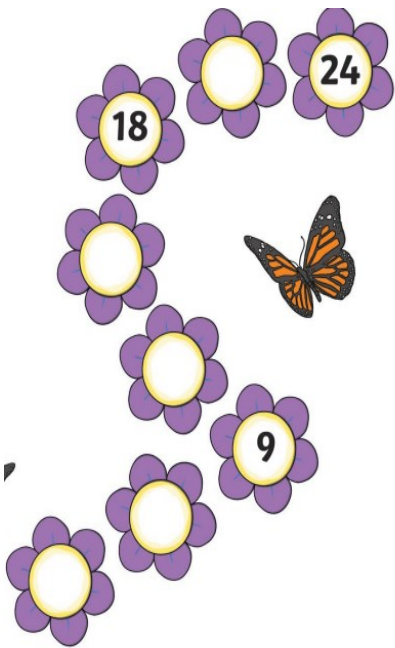
How you choose to present your home learning project is up to you but please send photos via dojo or email instead of sending physical projects into school! We appreciate your support with this.
